“Vieux Amis” (Old Friends) brings together three musical friends, neighbours and long-standing colleagues. Violinist Justine Cormack, cellist James Bush and pianist Sarah Watkins all grew up together in Christchurch.

Ever the innovator, Justine dedicated her energies to nurturing and promoting the best of New Zealand arts and music through her performances with NZTrio. James focussed on baroque performance, which has led him to work with many of Europe's top baroque orchestras and ensembles.

Sarah first teamed up with Justine when they were both at high school in Christchurch, playing chamber music together through the CSIM. Their careers have been intertwined ever since, most recently as founding members of NZTrio. Sarah and James have also performed together through their careers – their first outing for Chamber Music NZ was as a duo in 1996. The three musicians gave their first concerts as a trio in 1999.
